

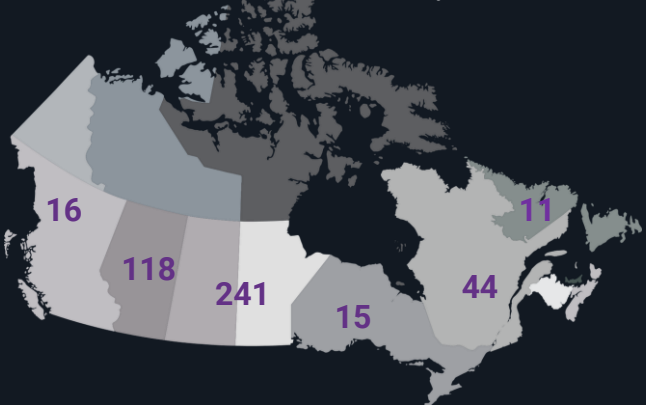


Take Action on Radon Radon Reduction Sweepstakes Report 2020-2021

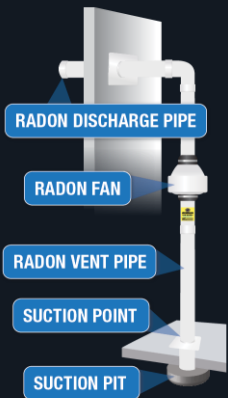
About the Sweepstakes

The sweepstakes provides 10 prizes of up to **\$1,000** each to homeowners who have tested their home for radon and used a C-NRPP professional to reduce levels to below Canada's recommended guideline of 200 Bq/m³.

The sweepstakes encourages Canadians to take action on radon, with the possibility of a cash reward.

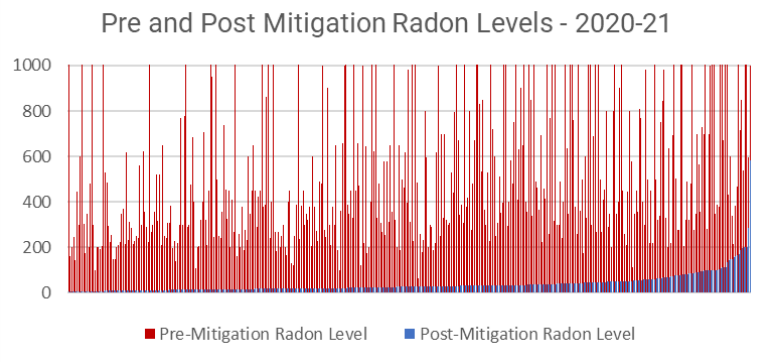


445 Entries Across Canada



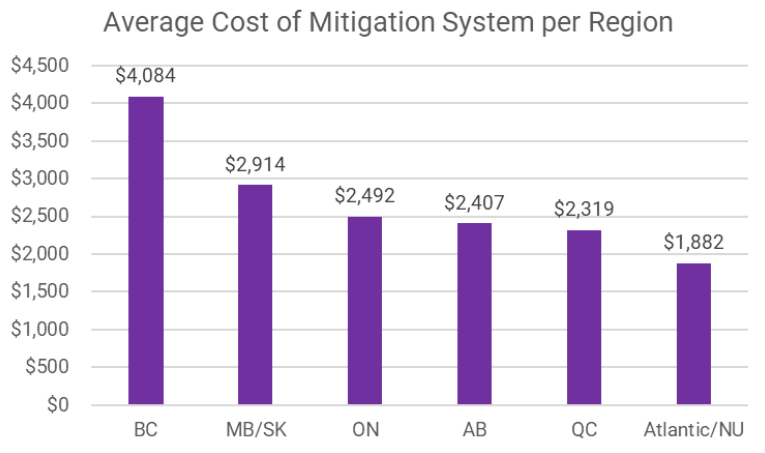
Radon Reduction System

Radon Levels BEFORE & AFTER Mitigation



C-NRPP professionals reduced radon levels to below 100 Bq/m³ over 93% of the time, and to below 50 Bq/m³ 79% of the time.

Average Cost of Radon Reducing Radon



The regional cost of radon mitigation ranged from approximately \$1,900 to \$4,000 with the national average at \$2,700.



- Radon exposure is linked to **3,000** lung cancer deaths in Canada each year.
- Reducing indoor radon levels is the only way to reduce radon-induced lung cancer risk.
- Certified radon professionals are trained to design and install radon mitigation systems to lower radon levels in Canadian homes.
